IMPORTANT NOTE: Licensed Seller and Other Manufacturer Fees apply to each calendar year; renewal fees are charged in January. Prorated fees are available to encourage new licensees during midyear. Contact CRRC for complete details.

LICENSING FEES DEFINITIONS/CLARIFICATIONS

Licensed Seller: A roofing product seller that has met and maintains compliance with the Program requirements and has signed the CRRC License Agreement; Licensed Sellers are limited to business entities that package, label and bring the Roofing Product to market.

Licensed Other Manufacturer (OM): A manufacturer that supplies a Roofing Product, component or raw material to a Licensed Seller, either directly or indirectly, and that has met and maintains compliance with the Program requirements and has signed the CRRC License Agreement; in the case of components or raw materials provided by the OM, they must solely determine the Radiative Properties of the final Roofing Product. Manufacturers that supply Roofing Products to others for private label sales are also within the scope of this definition.

Roofing Product Sales: The total dollar value of roofing products (e.g. thermoplastic & other single ply membranes, field-applied coatings, asphalt shingles, etc.) sold directly to distributors, installers and end-users. Sales of Factory-Coated Products and sales to other manufacturers/marketers that privately label and sell products under their own company and brand names are not included in Roofing Product Sales.

Factory-Applied Coatings: Products, such as paints and liquefied metal, applied in a uniform and continuous film to roofing products. The resulting surface film solely determines the radiative properties of such roofing products.

Factory-Applied Coating Sales: The total dollar value of products, such as paints and liquefied metal, applied as a uniform surface to Roofing Products and that solely determine the radiative properties of those roof surfaces. The dollar

value includes sales directly to end-users, Roofing Product sellers, plus sales to other intermediate users such as coil coaters, tile coaters, and metal fabricators.

Factory-Coated Product Sellers: Licensed Sellers who market Roofing Products (i.e. Factory-Coated Products) such as metal panels and concrete tiles, the radiative properties of which are solely determined by coatings which are applied to the product surfaces in controlled factory environments prior to such products being sold to distributors, installers and end-users.

IMPORTANT NOTE: There are additional fees associated with a product rating that are not listed in the above table. Fees will be incurred through initial/aged radiative properties testing performed by the Accredited Independent Testing Laboratory (AITL) of your choice. There is also a fee associated with sample weathering on the test farm. The CRRC does not regulate these costs; they are solely determined at the discretion of the AITL or Test Farm. Please contact your chosen AITL or Test Farm directly to discuss cost.

PRODUCT FEES DEFINITIONS/CLARIFICATIONS

Roofing Product, Production Line: A Roofing Product material that is not a Custom Color. Production Line Roofing Products are standard color offerings by the manufacturer and are promoted in general product information and in marketing materials.

Roofing Products, Standard: CRRC rated Production Line Roofing Products, excluding Color Family products.

Color Family. A CRRC pre-defined range of Hunter “L”, “a”, and “b” color values that establishes the color space for a CRRC pre-defined set of eighteen colors.

Color Family Group. One or more Production Line Roofing Products that are factory coated metal Roofing Products, that are rated by one CRRC Licensed Roofing Company, that have the same binder/resin technology, and that have color

properties and Radiative Properties that fall within the ranges established for the respective CRRC Color Family. All Color Family Elements within a single Color Family Group are assigned the same CRRC Product ID number.

Color Family Element. A uniquely formulated Roofing Product that is CRRC-rated as a member of a Color Family Group and that is either a Factory-Applied Roof Product Component that serves as the top coating on a factory coated metal Roofing Product or a metal Roofing Product that has as its top coating a Factory-Applied Roof Product Component.

Color Family Representative Element. A Color Family Element that is used to initially establish a Color Family Group.

Color Family Additional Element. A Color Family Element that is not the Color Family Representative Elements.

Custom Color: A unique Roofing Product color developed for the owner of a specific building or group of buildings on the same site that is produced in limited quantities and for a limited duration. A Custom Color is not individually promoted in general product information and marketing materials.

IMPORTANT NOTE: These fees only apply to Accredited Laboratories/Test Farms and new Laboratory/Test Farm applicants. They do not apply to companies seeking a product rating.

LABORATORY FEES DEFINITIONS/CLARIFICATIONS

Accredited Independent Testing Laboratory (AITL): A testing laboratory that is CRRC accredited to test Roofing Products and is completely independent from any Licensed Seller or Licensed Other Manufacturer.

Accredited Manufacturing Testing Laboratory (AMTL): A testing laboratory affiliated with a Licensed Seller or Licensed Other Manufacturer that is CRRC accredited to test the Radiative Properties of Roofing Products. Test results from an AMTL may be used only for Custom Color Roofing Products.

Approved Test Farm: A company that is CRRC approved and has exposure facilities at which product samples are exposed to the environment to obtain aged Radiative Properties.
